

A Message from Chairman, Buddy Bishop EARLY VOTING AND CANDIDATES NEXT YEAR

At the time of this writing, and according to the numbers gathered and recorded on the clip board at the Republican tent at the end of each early voting day, 2,884 people have participated in the process:



The number of individuals daily has slowly begun to climb, with the highest number being 208 on October 28th. It was of interest to see what the October 29th vote tally will be given that the Goochland Fall Festival; occurred essentially in the same place. But, 208 is still the highest count with the 29th coming in second place at 194.

Another interesting item on my mind is that with a simple public notice a goodly number of qualified people from District 4 have stepped forward to apply to fill the seat left vacant by the late Don Sharpe. It would be so cool to see the same goodly number of qualified conservatives and republicans from the other four districts, but that isn't likely – and – I think I know why.

In a word, its campaigning. Running for office is not exactly an easy process and it comes with the challenges of potential conflict among people who in any other circumstance would get along easily. October Business Meeting Highlights

PAM JOHNSON UPDATES THE COMMITTEE ON GOOCHLAND COUNTY ELECTION 2022

- Same Day Voter Registration will be handled by precinct Chiefs (and possibly assistant chiefs) but not the other Officers of Election. Poll watchers should be aware of this. Check in with Middle Resolution for clarity on this.
- So far, Goochland is averaging about 150 people a day in person early voting which is considerably less than last year.
- Election Officer Training will be the week of the 24th. If you have any questions, call the Registrar's office
- No voter registrations will be done on the weekend prior to election day
- A committee member commented about the hypocrisy of requiring election officers to provide an extensive employee identification verification, including a picture ID when state law has deemed photo ID unnecessary for voters.
- Another question was raised about the cost to the county for early voting. Pam indicated that there are 4 election officers working 8 hours every day of early voting at \$11/hour cost to the county, plus the added strain on the Registrar's office.



CHRIS AND DIANA, CAMPAIGN MANAGERS FOR BOB GOOD

- Chris emphasized the importance of this election as our county is at a crossroads
- With 27 years of experience in politics, he is most proud of his representation for Bob Good. In his freshman term, he is one of four leaders on the Freedom Caucus and he doesn't back down. He has a backbone unlike many politicians.
- **"Dems set the rules. Republicans need to learn how to play by them."** We need to knock on doors, help with phone campaigns, and remind all our fellow conservatives to vote. Even a little bit from everyone can accomplish a great deal.
- Question was raised about Good's efforts in election integrity. Chris responded with the congressman's bill "One man One Vote" requiring that federal money be withheld from states not requiring common sense policies like picture ID and secure drop-off ballot boxes.

- Chris encouraged everyone to contact him if you'd like Bob to come to your church. Bob attends a different church in his district every Sunday, worshipping at his own church once a month.
- He also encourages his constituents to call him about hosting a meet and greet at their home or other venue.

CHAIRMAN, BUDDY BISHIOP

- Buddy read a list of people who have worked in the Republican Tent during early voting and thanked them for their efforts. There was a dramatic pause as he read his name.
- The "mic malfunctioned" when he made mention of committee members working as Republican Election Officers during the early voting season. This commitment would make them less available to work the tent or as a poll watcher and some election officers are doing both!

VICE CHAIR, JIM HERRING

- Jim gave a passionate speech about how amazing it is to him that more people are not fired up and participating in the early voting, when we have one of the best conservative candidates to support. He bemoaned the frustration with

“Jellyfish Republicans” in our recent times whose remarkable capitulation has allowed the radical Dems to promote their policies.

- He heartily endorsed the excellence of Bob Good’s character and backbone who is not afraid to stand up for conservative values, even calling Pelosi “Person Speaker” boldly mocking the absurdity of radical Dems who oddly hype their inability to define a woman.

Update on the rules for observing election setup during early voting

TOO LATE TO SAY NOT SO FAST!

The rules in section 24.2-639 only refer to election day November 8th, not any day of early voting:

“---Before opening the polls, each officer shall examine the equipment and see that no vote has been cast and that the counters register zero. The officers shall conduct the examination in the presence of...one authorized representative of each political party...if such representatives are available.”

Why this odd difference in the rules?

In their haste, when the Democratic-controlled Virginia Assembly extended the early in-person voting period from 7 to 45 days in 2020, they failed to incorporate that change and other changes into other sections of the code.

The Charade of Six weeks of Early In-Person Voting

Who's available M-F during the hours of 8:30am to 4:30pm? Most working people are not. They're at work. And contrary to popular opinion, most retirees have busy schedules. So how do people benefit from having 4 election officers sitting in a room in Goochland waiting for them every day to vote for six weeks M-F 8:30-4:30? It's a farce and it does not help the majority of working class Virginians.

More importantly, in order to monitor the integrity of the election, people with a typical work week must take time off to participate. While it's stating the obvious, it still must be stated; **it's difficult to participate if you work a regular work week. But we do it anyway. We make it a priority.**

We have a couple Saturdays and a Sunday. This is actually helpful as it gives a few options for someone on a typical workweek to vote or take part in the integrity effort. But what about the other 30 work days? Why should people who do not work a typical workweek have *so much more*

access to in-person voting? Especially if they can vote by mail!

Why do they need 6 weeks? Are these people who are available during the work week unable to find time to be available in say, a two week window? And what about the Registrar's Office? Six weeks is 12% of their work year with the additional task to manage the process, including hiring election officers to have equal Rs and Ds, training them, issuing access to the state system, and vetting them. Was the Office of the Registrar equipped for the task of upholding the new Virginia State election laws? Is it really fair to them?

Could we as a committee do more to help the situation? Should we be more proactive in identifying the best election officers and encouraging them to participate so to spread the work among more people? How well prepared are election officers when the training is one hour? In multiple instances, election officers have been locked out of their sign-on and had to call over to the Registrar's office to get reinstated. Some election officers did not get sign-on credentials at all. It's a lot for the Registrar's office to manage.

The new voting laws create a silly charade. **But when considering the stakes**, some patriotic Goochlanders are **making it a priority** to take part in this absurd six week election "season" even if it means using valuable vacation days and otherwise making arrangements. We can't change state voting laws YET. Not to say this should even be a partisan issue because there are Dems working the elections who feel the same way.

Many voters ask questions when they come in to vote. Some are not clear on the new voting laws, which voting district they are in and even who's on the ballot this year in Goochland. So many people said "Where's Spanberger?" When they first look at their ballot they say, "Is this it?" *Yes, Mam, that's it. We're voting for our Congressman and we're in Virginia District 5.* Some voters wanted to hang around and chat about politics and election integrity. *Nope. Sorry sir, we need to ask you to leave the room now that you're done voting.* "I have no proof that I live in Goochland. I read somewhere that I can register and vote today...What's a provisional ballot?" People bring their ailing relatives in and want to "help" them vote. Some are indignant when it's explained that an authorization form must be filled out in order to provide assistance to a voter.

There are some very nice people who represent the democrats as election officers and I enjoy working with them. It's truly embarrassing when voters make snide comments about the voting machine, with the obvious implications. There's a time and place for that. But it's not at a polling place in front of people who have made it a priority to be involved in the election process. Clearly the cantankerous voters decided not to get involved. Yet they have no problem running their mouth at the people who have. "Is that thing hooked up to the internet?" *No sir, it's not.* "How many ballots does that thing hold? What do you do with it at night?" *It holds a lot and we keep a count of how many are in there. At the end of the day, the whole machine is locked up in the Registrar's office.* You want to say, *how about you get involved since you're so concerned?* But that would be unprofessional. So you offer them an "I Voted" sticker and say *thank-you!*

Bob Good – Working for us in DC

THE TRUCKING WORKFORCE IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 2022

October 7, 2022 **WASHINGTON, D.C.** – Congressman Good (R-VA) introduced the [Trucking Workforce Improvement Act](#) to repeal a new burdensome federal regulation on training for a commercial driver's license (CDL). This unnecessary regulation currently in effect mandates that truckers complete a federal government approved Entry-Level Driver Training (ELDT) in order to acquire a CDL license.

"Our farmers and manufacturers need to move their products to market, but they are facing a shortage in the trucking industry. The last thing Washington should do in this national shortage is impose more regulations that make it harder to find new drivers," **said Congressman Good (R-VA)**. "While the primary focus of the Biden Administration should be rebuilding the economy and putting Americans back to work so they can put food on the table for their families, they are piling on unnecessary burdens and costs on jobseekers. It will only deter qualified candidates, who need jobs quickly, from applying for these essential trucking positions. My Trucking Workforce Improvement Act of 2022 will remove these unnecessary regulations and put qualified applicants on the fast track to securing much-needed, well-paid jobs."

CONGRESSMAN GOOD VOTES AGAINST CONTINUING RESOLUTION

September 30, 2022 **WASHINGTON, D.C.** – Congressman Good (VA-05) voted against the Continuing Resolution passed by the U.S. House of Representatives today, which extends the government funding deadline from the original date of September 30th to December 16th. Passage of this spending bill will enable the Democrat Majority to pursue additional funding for their radical agenda after the November election.

"All Republicans should be against continuing the irresponsible Biden-Pelosi spending spree that has contributed to the record levels of inflation currently decimating family budgets. This Administration refuses to secure our Southern Border, protect innocent life, end extreme and harmful 'climate' initiatives, terminate the unjustified COVID-19 mandates, stop promoting CRT and other non-academic indoctrination in schools, or stop the weaponization of the FBI, IRS, and other agencies against the American people. Until

the Biden Administration puts Americans first, Republicans should not give them one more vote to take one more cent from hardworking taxpayers,” **said Congressman Good (R-VA).**

Congressman Good also signed onto a [letter](#) led by Rep. Chip Roy (R-TX) calling on Republican leadership to oppose any funding that furthers Biden’s America-last agenda or worsens record high inflation.

CONGRESSMAN GOOD INTRODUCES THE UNION INTEGRITY ACT TO PROTECT WHISTLEBLOWERS

September 21, 2022 **WASHINGTON, D.C.** – Congressman Bob Good (VA-05) introduced the [Union Integrity Act](#) to provide strong whistleblower protections for union employees who want to reveal corrupt and illegal practices of union bosses. The Union Integrity Act will prohibit labor unions from retaliating against any employee who provides information to authorities, testifies in enforcement proceedings, or refuses to perform tasks that violate the law.

“All too often, union employees are forced to decide between speaking out and facing retribution from their union leadership or staying silent. No employee in America should have to work in fear of calling out corrupt practices by union bosses. The common-sense protections in my Union Integrity Act will ensure that every American worker is protected under the First Amendment of the Constitution,” **said Congressman Good.**

Employees regularly feel compelled to join a union to work in their career field. In many states, employees can be fired for not paying their union dues, while the Department of Labor-Management Standards charges more than 100 union bosses each year for misuse of funds and embezzling.

“Our economic recovery is stifled by Democrat policies which encourage mandates, discourage work, enable big labor, and punish small businesses. Instead of working to eliminate unnecessary regulations and reduce tax burdens, Democrats want to pass the PRO Act which would essentially give union bosses unrestricted power. Workers who want to hold union leadership accountable for corrupt actions must be supported and emboldened to do so, and my Union Integrity Act will give them the protections they deserve.”




